CITY OF SOUTH SALT LAKE CANDIDATE FILING QUALIFICATIONS

Before the filing officer accepts any declaration of candidacy, the constitutional and statutory requirements for candidacy shall be read, and the candidate shall state whether he/she fulfills the requirements of candidacy. If the candidate indicates that such candidate does not qualify, the filing officer shall decline such person's candidacy.

Note: The qualifications to be a candidate are:

- 1) Be a United States citizen at time of filing.
- 2) Be at least 18 years old at the time of the next municipal election.
- 3) Must be a registered voter of the municipality.
- 4) Must be a resident of the municipality or a resident of the recently annexed area for 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the date of the election.
- 5) If elected from a council district, the person must be a resident of that council district.
- 6) In accordance with Utah Constitution Article IV, Section 6, any mentally incompetent person, any person convicted of a felony, or person convicted of treason or a crime against the elective franchise may not hold office in this state until the right to hold elective office is restored under Section 20A-2-101.3 or 20A-2-101.5
