### **After School Program Highly Qualified Teacher**

The Highly Qualified Teacher works under the direction of the Center Manager for After School Program tutoring; implements programming with youth.

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#### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS**

##### **EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE AND CERTIFICATIONS**

Graduation from an accredited four year college or university with a degree in education, must be a licensed educator (secondary). Preference will be given to teachers who hold highly qualified certification for Title I programs.

##### **NECESSARY KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES**

1. Skills and techniques used in a community learning center programs.
2. Skill in First Aid and CPR; skills in professional office settings, familiar with Microsoft office suite.
3. Ability to communicate effectively, verbally and in writing; ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with employees, supervisors, other agencies, participants, and the general public.

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#### **PHYSICAL DEMANDS/WORK ENVIRONMENT**
