What Happens Next?

STEP 1: Complete and return application

- Fill out all sections of the application
- Call if you need any assistance understanding or completing your application. .
- Return your application to the Urban Livability Department.

STEP 2: Meet with a Community Connection assistant

- Schedule a time to meet with a helpful assistant
- Walk through your property together and point out your needs and requests.
- Take photos of possible projects.

STEP 3: Application Review

- The Community Connection team will review your application to see:
 - What kinds of assistance you qualify for
 - What supplies, skills and time it will take to complete one or more of the projects you have requested
 - When your project fits on the schedule
- The team will contact you no more than 15 days after you apply to let you know which project requests we can support.

STEP 4: Project Setup

- The Community Connection team will come to your home to review the projects to be completed and schedule a day/time to complete.
- The team will discuss with you where supplies will be stored and where volunteers/workers will be allowed to go.

STEP 5: Project Day

- Community Connection will bring all tools, supplies and volunteers.
- You are welcome to participate in the project or simply chat with us.
- Depending on the length of the project, we may have breakfast, snack or lunch outdoors on your property.
- We will clean up all debris, materials and supplies at the end of the day. Your property will be left better than we found it.
