ESSENTIAL RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES

1. Removes, constructs and finishes concrete projects
 - 1.1 Removes existing concrete
 - 1.2 Reads and sets grade
 - 1.3 Constructs necessary forms for concrete pouring
 - 1.4 Assists with the finishing of newly poured curbs, gutters and sidewalks
 2. Operates a variety of equipment in performing street maintenance tasks
 - 2.1 Patches and repairs pot holes
 - 2.2 Assists with laying of asphalt and smoothing asphalt patches
 - 2.3 Repairs and replaces City street signs
 - 2.4 Cleans and storm drains and gutters
 - 2.5 Paints crosswalks, stop bars and legends.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE AND CERTIFICATIONS

- Graduation from high school or GED equivalent, or any equivalent combination of related education and experience.
